

Camp FAQ

What should my child wear to camp?

Campers should wear dance clothes. Girls should wear a leotard, tights, and dance pants, a tight t-shirt and shorts may substitute for a leotard. Boys should wear comfortable pants or shorts and a t-shirt. Campers should wear clean sneakers and have ballet or jazz shoes and tap shoes if possible. Campers may work in socks if they prefer.

What is a typical day for the children?

The children arrive between 9:45 and 10:00 and stay with their counselors. During the day students will attend six (6) 45 minutes classes. (Classes may be split based on age and experience.) For example, the first class of the day might be a hip hop dance class, followed by improvisational acting, then followed by voice. After approximately three classes students and counselors will eat lunch. After lunch students may learn a number for the show, then have an audition class, then an art class. Camp ends with a group meeting and discussion about the day's learning and experience.

What is the ratio of campers to counselors?

There is typically one counselor for every four campers.

Is there refrigeration for lunch?

No. Please pack a bag lunch. You may use thermal lunch boxes.

What happens if I forget to send lunch with my child?

You may bring lunch at any time. If that is not possible we will purchase lunch for your child but you must repay SHPA by the next day. Under no circumstances will any child be allowed to share lunch with another child.

Does Sleepy Hollow Performing Artists have any food restrictions?

Yes. No nuts of any kind and no chewing gum.

Are the campers ever left alone?

The children are never left alone. The counselors are always with the children.

Do the children ever go outside?

Yes. On lovely days campers will walk to one of the local parks for theater games and lunch.

Do I need to tell you in advance if I will need Extended Hours?

Yes. We need to have our counselors in place for the proper care of your child.

What are the charges for Extended Hours?

In the morning there is a charge of \$8 an hour from 9:00 – 10:00. Extended hours commence for all children who remain past 3:40. After 3:40 you will be charged \$8 an hour for any part of the hour your child remains in extended care. If picking up between 3:45 and 4:45 pm the charge will be \$8. If picking up between 4:45 and 5:45 the charge is \$16. If picking up between 5:45 and 6:00 pm, the charge is \$20.

When do the children perform?

The children perform every Friday from 3:00 – 3:30.

How much are the tickets for Friday performances?

Attendance is free and you can bring friends and relatives.

Can my child wait outside for me to pick them up?

No. Campers must wait inside the building. You may pull up in front of the studio and your child can exit. Or you can park in our lot and come in to pick up your child.

Does Sleepy Hollow Performing Artists have any food restrictions?

Yes. No nuts of any kind and not chewing gum.
